Please note that all prices quoted are in \$CDN.

Day 1 - Whirlpool Golf green fees (18 holes) are \$80.00 with cart, \$62.00 walking per person +tax; Due at Whirlpool Pro Shop prior to tee off. (cashless payment requested.)

Day 2 - Sawmill Golf green fees (18 holes) are \$53.00 with cart, \$35.00 walking per person; Due at Sawmill Pro Shop prior to tee off. (cashless payment required.)

Tourney Registration, participant & prize fees – mandatory*: 1 time \$20.00 per person due on registration.

Saturday dinner & reception: individuals pay-as-you-go at establishment TBA.

(Please indicate in registration if attending Dinner/reception, needed for reservation & numbers purposes.)

Sunday Collectors/Trade Space & Tables*: \$10.00/table for advanced reserved tables. Only 1 table/registrant please. Newcomer tables on day of the show will be \$20.00 each, cash.

*** Asterisk items are required to be paid in advance by use of the GHSC event e-registration website.** You will receive an e-ticket reservation for your golf selection (2-day or single day of choice) and/or your Sunday trader/sale table. Please pay your ticketed golf reservation and fees due at the designated golf course(s) you will be playing.

Hotel Information:

A **block of hotel rooms** has been advance reserved for tourney participants to book at a **special group price for “GHSC – Golf Historical Society” on Sep30 and Oct 1.** The group pricing and availability of rooms are valid only until end-of-day September 9th. The two hotels are both **Comfort Inns**, located in St. Catherines and Niagara Falls/Lundy’s Lane with relatively easy Highway or Expressway access to get to both golfing venues (30 mins max driving). Standard Rooms with 2 queen-size beds, and non-smoking are rooms available for your booking for 1 night or 2 nights. You may change/extend or upgrade rooms at an upcharge. (You are also free to book any other hotels to your liking in either city or Niagara Region on your own accord and choice, based on regular rack rates or available online rates. Note: Most of the larger & name brand hotels, closer to casinos & falls are in 300-400\$ CDN range.)

Canada Land Border Crossing Tips for USA visitors: see website: <http://cbsa-asfc.gc.ca/>

1. Required to have your US passport or other CBSA-acceptable citizenship document with you.
2. Current Canada Health regulations require you to be fully vaccinated* for covid for entry into Canada or be quarantined for weeks/simply refused entry.
3. All necessary documentation (e.g. vax records) and visit/contact info must be uploaded into the **ArriveCAN** app* for CBSA inspection, within 72 hrs advance of your arrival. There are no exceptions to this requirement. The border-crossing lineups requiring assistance are extremely long and you can be held up/delayed for hours.

Plan your trip stay, border crossing and travel times carefully.
