Golf has been played in the Port Fairy area since 1899.

Nevertheless, despite their ancient appearance, the town's current links are relatively recent. Located amidst an extensive dune system a few kilometres east of this beautiful seaside harbour town, the course was opened in 1963 as a member-designed, nine-hole layout. In 1985, the course was extended to eighteen holes, with the new holes being designed by 1958 Australian Amateur Champion Kevin Hartley. Since 2000, a later winner of the Australian Amateur Championship, Mike Clayton (1978), has been

advising the club on course design and conditioning.

Port Fairy Hickory Shaft Classic 2023

Conditions

Event: 18 holes individual stableford

Eligibility: • All welcome

Handicap: To convert GOLF Link daily handicap for hickory play:

• Add 3 shots for scratch to 3 handicap

Add 4 shots for 4-8 handicap

Add 5 shots for 9-14 handicap

• Add 6 shots for 15-20 handicap

Add 7 shots for 21 handicap and upwards

These provisions apply to players whose handicaps are based on play with modern equipment. For players whose handicaps are based solely on hickory play, there is no need to apply an adjustment.

Equipment:

Shafts must be wood or bamboo

Heads must be original (pre-1935) or approved replicas

Grips must be 'leather-wrap'

Any ball may be used

Rulings: Decisions of the organising committee shall be final

Rules: • Current R&A Rules of Golf

Local Rules of the host club

Ties: Ties for first place (only) will be decided by countback using the following method:

best score over the final nine holes is the winner

 if the best score for the final nine holes does not separate out a winner, the best score hole-by-hole backwards from the final hole will be used
