VICTOR HARBOR GOLF CLUB



Established in 1911, Victor Harbor Golf Club is the oldest golf club on Fleurieu Peninsula. A heavily-treed parkland layout with arguably Australia's most scenic first-tee, the course has hosted numerous amateur and professional championships. Designed in two stages—initially by Scottish immigrant professional James Herd 'Jack' Scott with later enhancements by well-known Melbourne golf course designer Vern Morcom—the course was home, in the late-1960s, to the world's first Ambrose event, the brainchild of American-born club member Dick Ambrose.

THE ROYAL ADELAIDE GOLF CLUB



Established in 1892, The Royal Adelaide Golf Club is South Australia's premier golf club. Designed in 1926 by legendary British golf course architect Dr Alister MacKenzie, the club's Seaton links are regarded as the state's finest championship layout. RAGC has hosted nine Australian Open Championships and sixteen Australian Amateur Championships.



FLEURIEU HICKORY GOLFERS

ELIGIBILITY

- FHG members and invited guests
- AGHS, GSA, HGQ, PGA and SoHG members
- Amateur players must have a GOLF Link handicap

EQUIPMENT

- Shafts must be wood or bamboo
- Heads must be original (pre-1935) or approved replicas
- Grips must be 'leather-wrap'
- Any ball may be used

RULES

- Current R&A Rules of Golf
- Local Rules of the host club

TIES

- For the individual championship (only), ties for first place will be decided by sudden death playoff
- For all other events, ties will be decided by countback using the following method:
 - best score over the final nine holes is the winner
 - if the best score for the final nine holes does not separate out a winner, the best score hole-by-hole backwards from the final hole is used

RULINGS

- Decisions of the organising committee shall be final
