

The Inaugural Bluegrass Hickory Open
October 19 – 22



Join fellow hickory players from across the country for this inaugural event to be played annually on the historic Owl Creek Country Club. This course designed by Mr. George Davies, born in Liverpool, England, is known for being the designer of 40 courses in his lifetime with many in Indiana and Kentucky.

This will be a unique tournament as we are playing at the aforementioned historic Owl Creek Country Club founded in 1927. **BUT** we are offering additional events that will have you wanting to return next year and years after.

We start on Saturday afternoon with a private event at Churchill Downs, the home of the Historic Kentucky Derby. We will tour the track and the museum with a life-like movie of the Derby and have time to visit the backside where the stables and trainers have their own city which is not open to the public.

Sunday will be your practice round followed by a short bus ride in the afternoon to the grounds of the world-famous Jim Beam Distillery in Clermont, Kentucky. Once we arrive there will be a tour of the Knob Creek Distillery, that is not open to the public, followed by tastings and Kentucky themed hors d'oeuvres. There will be a presentation of the history of bourbon as well as a mingle time with Baker Beam who will sign bottles for each player of his latest bourbon release.

Monday we will have your first round with an evening banquet.

Tuesday we will have the final round with a "shot gun" start with the awards luncheon afterwards.
